The majority of PIBA programs are a minimum of three hours and will qualify you for Certification Maintenance (CM) points, which are requested from the American Board of Industrial Hygiene (ABIH) for EH&S Events. Events of 3 hours in length qualify for 0.5 CM points; 6 hours qualify for 1.0 CM point. The Board of Certified Safety Professionals offers Continuation of Certification (COC) points at a rate of 0.625 for every 1 ABIH CM point.
