Cosco Busan Oil Spill in San Francisco Bay:

The November 7, 2007 Cosco Busan Oil Spill in San Francisco Bay had a significant effect on the regional environment and the economy. This presentation will provide a first-hand account of the spill response; challenges faced by local, state, federal and industry responders and stakeholders, and ways in which those challenges were addressed. The preparedness and response roles and responsibilities of industry and local, state and federal agencies will also be discussed. Recordings of the communication between the Cosco Busan and the United States Coast Guard and the vessel's movement up to the collision with the Bay Bridge will also be provided.

PIBA is connecting you with a direct link to Mr. Bill Robberson, P.E., Regional Response Team IX, US EPA Region 9. You will hear detailed information about the oil spill and how it affected the regional economy, the environment, and residents of the San Francisco Bay Area. You will be provided the advantage of getting immediate answers to your questions, as well as being able to share your views and opinion with others. You will also glean information/network with the environmental community representatives in attendance.

Our Speaker - Commander William Robberson:

Commander William (Bill) Robberson is a Commissioned Officer in the US Public Health Service and has been with EPA Region 9 for over 22 years; he is a Licensed Civil Engineer (P.E.) in CA.

Bill leads the EPA Region 9 component of the Regional Response Team (RRT), a response support and coordinating body comprised of federal, state and tribal representatives and participants from industry and local agencies. He is also the EPA Region 9 Incident Management Team (IMT) Command Liaison Officer. Prior to this assignment, Bill was a member of the Region's Oil Team; in 1996 he assembled and led the Region's cross-media workgroup on MTBE; he managed EPA's State of California Drinking Water Program for 9 years; and he was program manager for EPA's Waste Water Treatment Construction Grants projects in the SF Bay and Los Angeles Areas.

Bill flew for the Navy for 18 years both operationally and as a flight test pilot; he is also a licensed Airline Transport Pilot (ATP).
