Course Description:

The US Department of Transportation requires all Hazmat Employees (employees who directly affect safety during transportation of hazardous materials in commerce) to have training on the Hazardous Materials Regulations. This includes personnel who are involved in preparing and offering hazardous materials and hazardous wastes for transportation, including classification, identification, packaging, marking, labeling, and completing or signing shipping papers, and those who transport these materials in commerce.

This 8-hour training is designed to meet the classroom training requirements of the Department of Transportation's Hazardous Materials Regulations found in 49 CFR 172.704 (for road shipping) and IATA's Dangerous Goods Regulations, section 1.5 (for air shipping), including:

- General Awareness
- Function Specific Shipper Topics
- Safety and Emergency Response
- Security Awareness

The material provided for the class includes:

- Qualified instructor
- Course outline
- Lesson plan
- Handouts/Workbook
- Exam to be given at the end of class
- Shipper Certification (valid for 3 years)

Note: This introductory/refresher training does not provide in-depth hands-on instruction on material classification, shipping descriptions, packaging material selection, or multi-modal/multi-jurisdictional requirements.
